

Help Rename the Cypress Senior Center

The Cypress Senior Citizens Commission agrees that the Senior Center would benefit from a new name and brand. We're looking for suggestions and welcome your ideas.



Reason for Renaming the Senior Center:

The population and demand for older adult programming in Cypress has expanded. To remain relevant and attract future generations of participants, as other cities have done, the time has come to rename and re-brand the Senior Center to better serve the changing interests of our growing community.

Criteria for New Name Suggestions:

1. A significant geographical, natural, historical or cultural distinction relevant to Cypress.
2. Recognition of individual(s) or group who has made an exemplary contribution to the city and its residents. Individuals can be either living or deceased.
3. Recognition of national or local heroes; or historical people who have provided outstanding service to the state or country.
4. Word(s) that conveys the concept and purpose of the Senior Center.
5. Does not duplicate or have similarity to other facility names in our region.
6. Avoid names of persons currently in political office or employed by the City; persons convicted of crime or moral turpitude.

Selection Process:

All suggestions submitted to the Cypress Senior Citizens Commission will be considered, but it reserves the right to reject proposed name changes if they are deemed to be offensive, controversial, or do not represent the best interests of the community. The Commission will make its recommendation to the Cypress City Council for final approval.
