



Help Prevent Contamination of Our Recycling Stream

Why Source Separating out Recyclables from the Trash is Important

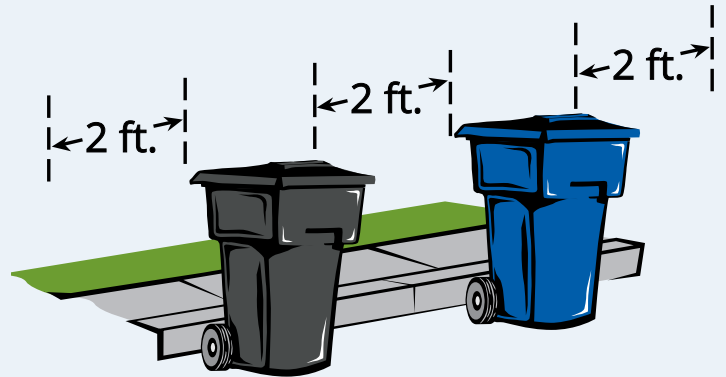
When items unfit for recycling are placed in our recycling bins, they have the potential for contaminating and turning your recyclables into waste. Keep these materials out of our recycling bins.

- NO:** Plastic containers that have hazardous chemicals such as motor oil, pesticides, herbicides and lighter fluid
- NO:** Broken glass, glassware, bakeware, mirrors, light bulbs, window glass, vases or ceramics
- NO:** Green waste, dirt, rocks or bricks
- NO:** Broken furniture, batteries, tools, tire or garden hoses



CART PLACEMENT & GUIDELINES

Place carts at the collection site on your collection day about 2 feet apart. - if you do not have curb side room please contact VVSOC for assistance.



Give at least two (2) feet of clearance on all sides.

- Both wheels should be against the curb or edge of street with cart handles facing your property.
- Place your three carts at the collection site the night before your collection day, no earlier than 5 p.m., or on the day of collection by 6 a.m.
- Close the lid when moving the carts around.
- Do not place in your carts hot ashes/ coals. Place cooled ashes/coals in a sealed container then put them in the black trash cart.
- Do not place in your carts any medical products, toxic, hazardous and liquid waste. For proper disposal please visit www.oilandfills.com or call 714-834-6752.
