



GUIDELINES:

1. PARKS DEPARTMENT WILL MARK SIGN POST PLACEMENT IN FIELD FOR APPROVAL BY CITY ENGINEER.
2. SIGN HEIGHT AND DIMENSIONS MAY VARY UPON WRITTEN APPROVAL OF CITY ENGINEER.
3. ALL WORK TO BE IN DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH APWA STANDARD PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, LATEST EDITION.
4. SIGN SHALL BE LOCATED SO AS TO NOT BLOCK SIGHT DISTANCE AND SHALL REQUIRE REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER.
5. PARKS DEPARTMENT SHALL COORDINATE WITH MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT SO AS TO NOT INTERFERE WITH IRRIGATION SYSTEM.
