

Resources for Recycling Computers, Computer Monitors & Televisions

Computer monitors and televisions contain Cathode Ray Tubes (CRTs). The State of California has determined that CRTs are now a hazardous waste. CRT's contain high quantities of lead, which can cause poisoning in individuals and can be especially harmful to young children.

CRTs are hazardous; therefore they CANNOT be disposed of in landfills.

Orange County Households may properly dispose of their CRTs at an O.C. Regional Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center. (Business generated waste is not accepted.)
