

FREE Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

Orange County HHW Collection

Leftover household products containing corrosive, toxic, ignitable or reactive ingredients are considered household hazardous waste or HHW. Products such as paints, cleaners, oils, batteries and pesticides that contain potentially hazardous ingredients require special care when you dispose of them and should **NEVER** be thrown in the trash.



City of Cypress residents can dispose of their household hazardous waste items for FREE at any of the County's four Household Hazardous Waste Collection Centers.

Bulky Items and E-Waste Collection

Love to Clear Out Clunky Junk?

Valley Vista Services of Orange County provides Cypress residents with two **FREE** Special Collection Pick-ups per year at no additional charge. We can collect **Bulky Items** which are any items too large to fit into the standard collection cart like refrigerators and couches and/or **E-Waste** items such as computers, keyboards, monitors or other electronic devices banned from landfills.



Bulky Items and E-Waste are only picked up on Wednesdays, so residents must call VVSOC at least 24 hours in advance to schedule a special collection pick-up.

When conducting home improvement projects VVSOC provides FREE, safe and convenient SHARPS collection and disposal services. Some examples of sharps items include needles, syringes, lancets and auto-injectors like epinephrine and insulin pens.

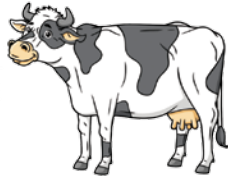
You may request SHARPS containers for storing and mailing upon request at no additional cost, and should receive an empty SHARPS container kit, pre-paid postage and disposal kit within one week of your request. The best thing about using this service is that it's completely confidential.
